





My research is performing techno economic assessment into the inclusion of green hydrogen into a remote microgrid. The purpose is to increase the use of renewable energy and reduce emission.

I was looking for something where I can exercise my knowledge gained from previous degrees. I am glad that I can do that here. I like performing techno-economic assessments of renewable energy systems. That was something I always wanted to do. Therefore, I am pursuing a Master by Research as a full-time international student.

CQU offered me a scholarship which covers my living. What else can I expect? I am doing what I wanted to do; I am pursuing a research degree and they look after my living. I am establishing a network with industry people along with academics.

In Cairns I get everything I need to live well. In fact, long term rental costs are cheaper here compared to big cities. I am always busy with something - I come to campus and go home everyday with a view of the Esplanade. During weekends, I play cricket for a club and travel around the city. There is a lot to be explored here from the mountains to the ocean. I have many friends to hang out with and sometimes we play volleyball in the evening. I also work at a casual position once a week. I strongly believe that International students should consider Cairns to study!

WORKING HOLIDAY


Cairns is the perfect place for a working holiday. You will find strong demand for workers in multiple sectors - an opportunity to get paid to work and play in one of the most diverse and beautiful destinations on earth while working in restaurants, hotels, farms, schools and community projects.

VOLUNTEERING

If you are looking to give back to the Cairns community and gain valuable life experiences, volunteering can be the perfect option. There are opportunities in all shapes and sizes according to your skills. It can be a one-time experience (beach cleanup, food bank) or an ongoing activity (animal rescue, mentoring, customer service). Not only does volunteering make you feel good, it helps you connect with new people and enhance your Australian experience!



After completing your studies, there are incentives for students to seek employment and sponsorship opportunities in Cairns as a regional area. After graduating in a Bachelor or Master Degree course in Cairns you will be able to apply for a temporary graduate visa for up to 2 years, which may be extended up to 4 years once you have lived and worked in the same regional area for 2 years. Cairns also provides employment sponsorship opportunities under the FNQ DAMA regional migration agreement and through Queensland skilled migration program.

HOMESTAYS

PURPOSE-BUILT STUDENT ACCOMMODATION

Cairns has a number of high quality, modern and new purpose-built student accommodation operations centrally located and close to the centre of Cairns, where many colleges and university campuses are based.

Tenancy arrangements are flexible, allowing for short-term and long-term stays. Many facilities provide all the bedding and ancillary items required so that all you need to bring are your personal items.

The options range from studio apartments to shared rooms with up to two beds, with communal areas and facilities.

The residences are often centrally located and near public transport, making it convenient for getting around the city. Bills such as electricity and internet are generally included, so the cost of living should not change from month to month.

You can rent a property by yourself or with friends. This can be done through a real estate agent or privately.






Cairns is serviced by public transport, and if you are a uni or VET student, you receive a 50% discount on your bus travel fares.
